Dental healthcare workers are on the front line of the efforts to minimize the spread of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) have identified the aerosols created by high speed hand pieces and ultrasonic or piezo scalers in dental offices as a major concern for the spread of this virus.

The CDC and the American Dental Association (ADA) have recommended that elective, or non-urgent dental procedures be postponed to help reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19.
