- > The Battelle Critical Care Decontamination System (CCDS) decontaminates thousands of N95 respirators at once using vapor phase hydrogen peroxide.
- > The Battelle CCDS is designed to work on N95 respirators for the removal of the novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2).
- > The Battelle CCDS is available to Missouri healthcare providers and first responders at no cost to the state or providers.

The CCDS is available **at no cost** through an Emergency Use Authorization from the Food and Drug Administration.

### Sign up with Battelle online

Visit [battelle.org/decon](https://battelle.org/decon) to fill out the enrollment form. Battelle will email an agreement, instructions, and a point of contact (POC).



### Contact Battelle to get your code

The enrollee completes the agreement and contacts their Battelle POC to receive their 3 digit code for each facility.



### Collect and label N95 respirators

N95 respirators must be unsoiled (free of blood, mucus, makeup, etc.) and labeled with a permanent marker.



### Bag labeled N95 respirators and ship to the CCDS site

Double bag the labeled N95 respirators and label the shipping box with your 3 digit facility code. Ship via FedEx to 801 Armory Dr, Jefferson City, MO 65109.



### Receive decontaminated N95 respirators, ready for reuse

Your shipments are barcoded to ensure chain of custody. You receive your own facility's respirators back decontaminated and ready for reuse.
