As Director of the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (“Department”), pursuant to Executive Orders 20-04 and 20-19, I am vested with the authority to temporarily waive or suspend the operation of any statutory requirement or administrative rule, upon approval of the Office of the Governor. After consultation with and receiving approval from the Office of Governor, I am hereby waiving the following laws in order to assist the state, and its citizens prepare and respond to COVID-19 until March 31, 2021, unless otherwise modified by the Department.

Personal Care Assistance Plan Monitoring

Section 208.918.2(3)(b) shall be waived to the extent necessary to temporarily suspend the requirement for vendors to make face-to-face visits for performance of personal care assistance plan monitoring.
