Naloxone Training of Trainers

The MO-HOPE Project will conduct an overdose education and naloxone distribution training of trainers. This training will teach participants to train individuals and organizations to educate patients or clients at risk of witnessing or experiencing an opioid overdose on factors that contribute to their risk, risk mitigation strategies, and overdose reversal protocols.

Other items for discussion include:

- Foundation of substance use disorder as a mental health condition
- Co-prescription of naloxone for patients in recovery or on high MME prescription
- Overview of efforts to address the opioid epidemic
- Recommending or distributing naloxone

At the conclusion of the training, participants will be provided slides to be utilized in their own trainings.
