Organ Donation Advisory committee Governor Makes Appointments Senate Confirms Appointments

The Governor's Organ Donation Advisory Committee is a ten member committee which has four organ procurement agency representatives; four organ recipients, families of organ recipients, organ donors, or family of organ donors; one health care representative (hospital); and one Department of Health and Senior Services (Department) representative. (194.300 RSMo.)

Charge - 194.297, 194.299, and 194.302, (RSMo)

- Recommend priorities in the expenditures from the Organ Donor Fund.
- Assist in the development of organ donor awareness programs to educate the public about the importance of organ donation.
- Submit a report of activities and recommendations to the Governor, the general assembly, and to the director of the Department.

Commitment

- Support the Department in maintaining an effective and efficient donor registry.
- Encourage partnerships and collaborate in efforts to provide educational activities at the local and regional levels.
- Review and recommend to the Department actions needed to increase donor awareness while maximizing the Organ Donor Fund's limited resources.
- Encourage fund donations to support educational efforts and registry maintenance and enhancements.
