Donate Life Missouri Registry: The registry is a statewide, voluntary, confidential registry of organ and tissue donors. It is a first-person consent registry making your decision legally binding unless revoked in a manner provided by law.

Funding: Program is solely funded by voluntary contributions and gifts. No General Revenue. No federal grants. MSECC is one of the voluntary funding streams. Recent legislative changes will give the program opportunity to seek funding. General Revenue cannot supplant the Organ Donor Program Fund 0824.

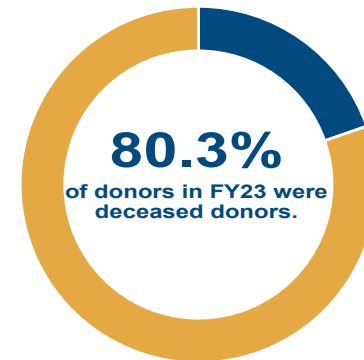
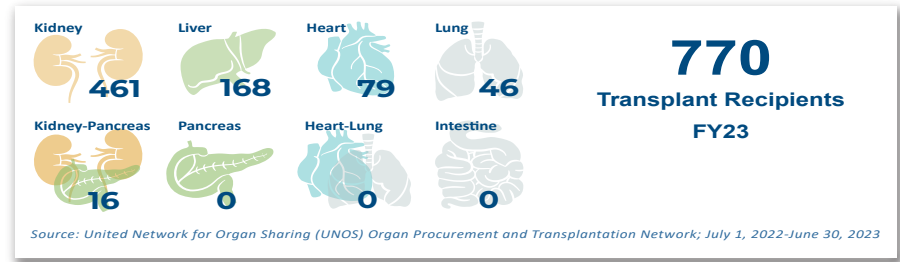
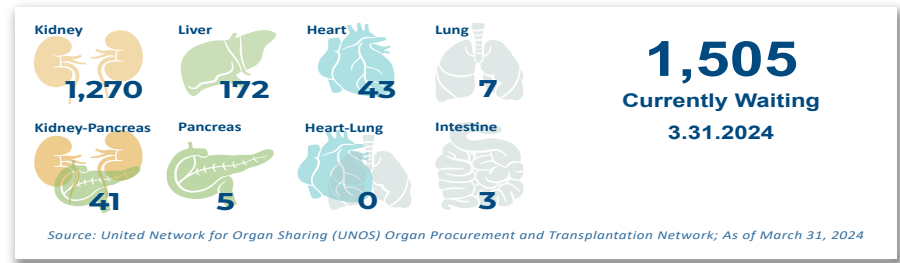
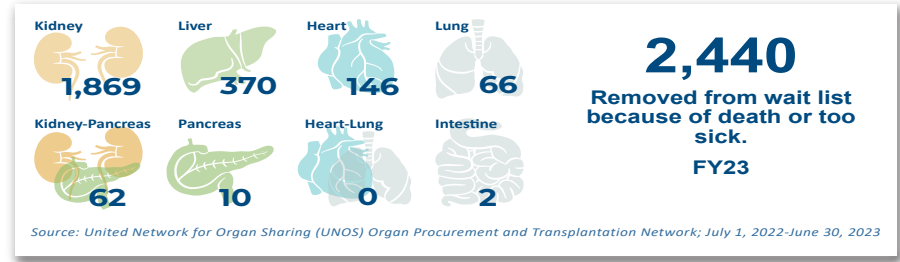
1. Increase available organs and tissue through education and an effective, confidential registry of potential donors.

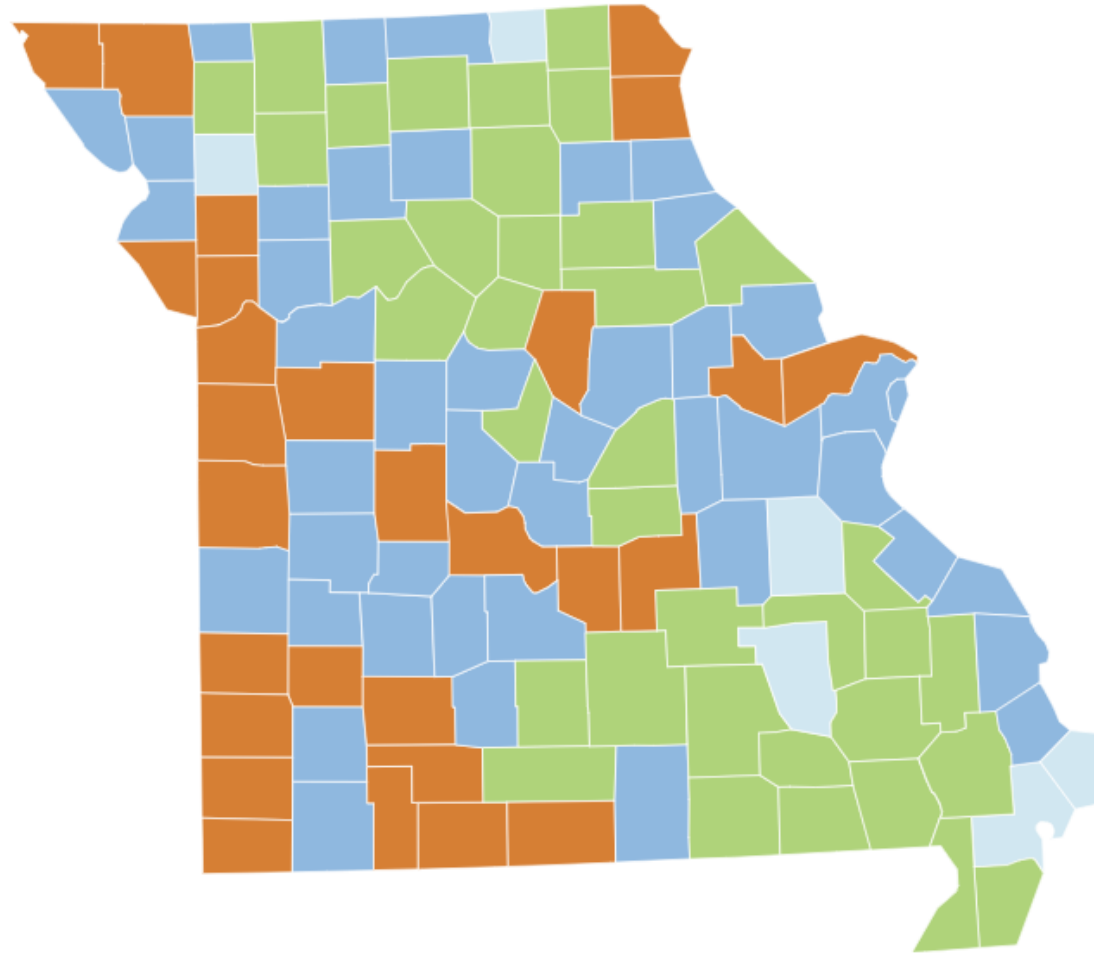
