HOW TO ADDRESS YOUTH VAPING AND TOBACCO USE?

A comprehensive tobacco-free campus policy that includes full implementation of all of the following:

- $\checkmark\,$ Evidence-based prevention education for all students.
- Access to and wide promotion of evidence-based cessation resources to help those wanting to quit.
- Consistent and frequent communication about the policy and related practices.
- Consistent and friendly enforcement with everyone. Instead of suspension, offer cessation access and require an evidence-based supportive discipline program for students.
- \checkmark Engage students in policy adoption and implementation.



Implement Prevention Education for all Students in all Grades <u>CATCH My Breath</u>, <u>Tobacco Prevention Toolkit</u>, <u>Vaping</u>: <u>Know the Truth</u>, <u>ASPIRE</u>, or Tobacco Prevention and Education Resource Center.



Offer and Promote Cessation for Everyone Find training for professionals through <u>Not On Tobacco</u> or <u>ACT to Address Youth</u> <u>Cessation</u>.

For students - <u>My Life My Quit</u>, <u>NOT for Me</u> For staff, contractors and visitors - <u>MO Tobacco Quit Services</u>.



Implement Alternative to Suspension

Two evidence-based options are available to implement as a supportive discipline program, <u>INDEPTH</u> or <u>Healthy Futures</u>. Offer cessation access through <u>My Life My Quit</u>, <u>NOT for Me</u>. Find training for professionals through <u>Not On Tobacco</u> or <u>ACT to Address</u> <u>Youth Cessation</u>.
