<b>Qualifying Patient</b> 	<p>Individual diagnosed with at least one qualifying medical condition</p> <p><i>*If under 18, must have legal guardian consent and supervision</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6 ounces in 30-day period.</li> <li>• DCR-issued patient ID and government-issued ID.</li> <li>• Taxed at 4% plus general and local taxes.</li> </ul>	<p>60-day supply</p>
<b>Primary Caregiver</b> 	<p>Individual (21+) who has significant responsibility for managing the well-being of up to 6 qualifying patients</p>	<p>Per qualifying patient:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6 ounces in 30-day period.</li> <li>• DCR-issued caregiver ID and government-issued ID.</li> <li>• Taxed at 4% plus general and local taxes.</li> </ul>	<p>60-day supply for each qualifying patient</p>
<b>Consumer</b> 	<p>Individual at least 21 years old</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 ounces in a single transaction.</li> <li>• Government-issued ID.</li> <li>• Taxed at 6% plus general and local taxes.</li> </ul>	<p>3 ounces at one time</p>

Public consumption of marijuana is not allowed. Article XIV does not permit driving or operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of marijuana. Consumption of marijuana product on the premises of a licensed dispensary, including in approved transport vehicles, is strictly prohibited.
