Qualifying Patient



Individual diagnosed with at least one qualifying medical condition

*If under 18, must have legal guardian consent and supervision

- 6 ounces in 30-day period.
- DCR-issued patient ID and governmentissued ID.
- Taxed at 4% plus general and local taxes.

60-day supply

Primary Caregiver



Individual (21+) who has significant responsibility for managing the well-being of up to 6 qualifying patients Per qualifying patient:

- 6 ounces in 30-day period.
- DCR-issued caregiver ID and governmentissued ID.
- Taxed at 4% plus general and local taxes.

60-day supply for each qualifying patient

Consumer



Individual at least 21 vears old

- 3 ounces in a single transaction.
- Government-issued ID.
- Taxed at 6% plus general and local taxes.

3 ounces at one time

Public consumption of marijuana is not allowed. Article XIV does not permit driving or operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of marijuana. Consumption of marijuana product on the premises of a licensed dispensary, including in approved transport vehicles, is strictly prohibited.
