The Division of Cannabis Regulation (DCR) requires a full and complete submission for items to be reviewed for compliance with 19 CSR 100-1.120(1). Licensees are required to submit items in Metrc and follow-up with the additional required information through email at CannabisProductCompliance@health.mo.gov. If all required information is not submitted the same day, the application may be denied as an incomplete submission. An Item Approval Application is required for new Template, Template-based, and Non Template Item submissions.

This final marijuana product originated from marijuana grown and cultivated in a licensed cultivation facility located in Missouri pursuant to 19 CSR 100-1.100(4)(I). For manufacturing facility licensees only: the Licensee attests any tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), such as THC-A, Delta-8, or Delta-10, in this final marijuana product is derived only from marijuana cultivated in Missouri by a licensed cultivator, as required by 19 CSR 100-1.170(2)(E).

This final marijuana product is intended for human use; and the label required by 19 CSR 100-1.120(1)(C)2 includes all ingredients, whether or not the ingredients contain cannabinoids.

This final marijuana product does not contain chemical modifications, conversations, or synthetic derivation of cannabinoids to produce intoxicating cannabinoids isomers, including those created by heat or other process during use by a patient or consumer, and all cannabinoids acquired from entities other than marijuana facilities for purpose of inclusion in marijuana product were accompanied by a Certificate of Analysis at the time of acquisition that identified the testing lab that tested the product and listed the product's ingredients, pursuant to 19 CSR 100-1.170(2)(F).
