#### Packaging Requirements (Check that the product meets these requirements)

- Package or label is not designed in a false or misleading manner.
- Package is not designed in a manner to cause confusion between a marijuana product and any product not containing marijuana.
- Not packaged or labeled in any manner designed to appeal to a minor as pursuant to 195.805 RSMo.
- Clearly and conspicuously labeled with "Marijuana" or "Marijuana-infused product" in a font size at least as large as the largest other font size used on the package including all logos, branding or any other artwork that may contain words, letter or characters.
- Contains the following warning statement in a font no smaller than seven- (7-) point type: "Warning: Cognitive and physical impairment may result from the use of Marijuana."
- Package in opaque, re-sealable and child resistant packaging.  
Products not packaged for retail sale before delivery to a dispensary **must** be packaged by the dispensary upon sale to a qualifying patient or caregiver.
- No branding, artwork, or other information or design elements obscures any required information.
- Package and label **does not** include claims of health benefits. Health warnings are permissible.
- Marijuana and marijuana-infused products **is at all times** to be tagged with traceability information generated by the statewide track and trace system.

**Label Requirements (Check that the product meets these requirements)**

- Marijuana and marijuana-infused products includes a label displaying the following information, **in the following order:**
  - Total weight of the marijuana included in the package.
    - For dried, unprocessed marijuana, weight must be listed in ounces or grams;
    - For concentrates, weight must be listed in grams;
    - For infused products, weight must be listed by milligrams of THC.
  - Dosage amounts
  - Instructions for use
  - Estimated Length of time the dosage will have an effect
  - The THC per dosage
  - The tetrahydrocannabinol acid per dosage
  - The cannabidiol per dosage
  - The cannabidiol acid per dosage
  - The cannabinol concentration per dosage
  - All active and inactive ingredients, which must not include groupings of ingredients that obscure the actual ingredients, such as “proprietary blend” or “spices”
  - In the case of dry, unprocessed marijuana, the name, as recorded with the Missouri Secretary of State’s Office, of the cultivation facility from which the marijuana in the package originated.  
In the case of infused products, the name, as recorded with the Missouri Secretary of State’s Office, of the infused product manufacturer from which the product originated
  - A “best if used by” date

**Edible Packaging Requirements (Check that the product meets these requirements – MAN only)**

- Package is stamped with the universal symbol for medical marijuana products  
*(Applicable to edible marijuana-infused products with ten or more milligrams THC only)*
  - A diamond containing the letters “THC” with a letter “M” located under the “THC” within the diamond.
  - The number of milligrams of THC in the package is in the vicinity of the universal symbol.
  - The symbol shall be placed on the front of the package in red and white print and measures one-half inch by one-half inch from point to point.

- All edible marijuana-infused products must be packaged for retail by the infused products manufacturer before transfer to a dispensary.
