

First Aid and CPR Certification Extension

Through recommendation from the American Heart Association, the Section for Child Care Regulation will be allowing an extension of 120 days past the expiration for any of the approved First Aid/CPR certification that will expire in 2020. Please retain your current documentation showing your certification in one of the below models. That documentation will be valid for 120 days beyond the current expiration. If your documentation is on the Toolbox training report please print or electronically store a copy prior to the expiration of your certification as those records will fall off upon their expiration.

Please remember as you are able to locate First Aid and CPR training, the licensing rules require that it must contain an in-person skills assessment to be accepted by SCCR. Online only First Aid/CPR is not accepted.
