




Medical Marijuana Facility Progress



<u>Note 1:</u> Minimum Standards Review - all licensed and certified medical marijuana facilities, excluding Seed to Sale vendors, must complete the Department's minimum standards review process. The green bar indicates how many of these reviews have been completed.

<u>Note 2:</u> The figure for completed Minimum Standards Reviews includes thirty-one reviews that were completed for a facility license or certification that has since been deactivated – there are currently twenty-four Minimum Standards Reviews remaining.

<u>Note 3:</u> Change Request - if a facility chooses to make certain changes to what it originally proposed in its application for licensure, it must first seek and obtain Department approval for those changes.

<u>Note 4:</u> Commencement Inspection - each facility must request a Commencement Inspection from the Department when it has completed the Minimum Standards Review and is ready to begin operating. Once a facility has completed the Commencement Inspection, it will receive approval to operate and may then begin working with medical marijuana.

<u>Note 5:</u> Operational Deadline Variance Request - each facility is required by rule to become operational within one year of their license issuance date; facilities that are unable to become operational within one year are required to submit a variance request to extend their operational deadline, which must be approved or denied by the Department.
