As Director of the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (“Department”), pursuant to Executive Orders 20-04 and 20-12, I am vested with the authority to temporarily waive or suspend the operation of any statutory requirement or administrative rule, upon approval of the Office of the Governor. After consultation with and receiving approval from the Office of Governor, I am hereby waiving the following laws in order to assist the state, and its citizens prepare and respond to COVID-19 until December 30, 2020, unless otherwise modified by the Department.

AAA Annual Onsite Evaluations of Service Providers-Contractors for Compliance Monitoring

19 CSR 15-4.220(3) shall be waived to the extent necessary to temporarily allow the use of live video technology for area agencies on aging to conduct annual compliance monitoring evaluations of service providers.
