## MEMORANDUM FOR SECTION OF ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES STAFF

Subject: Protective Service Response Policy Updates

Effective March 11, 2024, updates have been made to policy 1703.10, Protective Services Response, to reflect the following changes:

- Clarification added on the initiation of reports, including the following:
  - o Timeframes,
  - Initiation date field,
  - Consideration of whom to initiate the report with when the reporter isn't available,
  - Prior history/Background checks,
  - How to handle reports with no identifiable ANE,
  - Restricting reports,
  - Duplicate reports,
  - Grouping reports, and
  - Reclassifying reports.
- Clarification added on reporter contact and timeframe requirements.
- Clarification of the number of face-to-face attempts with the eligible adult prior to postponement or waiver.
- Separated postponement and waiver requirements for face-to-face interview with the eligible adult.
- Separated postponement and waiver requirements for the safety plan.
- Clarification of HIPAA requirements.
- Clarification added on when a report may be cancelled.
- Clarification on closing reports by defining and amending closing and cancelling dispositions and updating closing timeframes.
- Updated the extension reasons to match MoAPSS.
