

## Quick Guide: MOAPSS Interventions

Any services the APS Specialist or other involved professionals provided, attempted to provide, or referred the eligible adult to while responding to the report, in addition to those the eligible adult already has, shall be added to the Interventions Tab.

Select **+ New Case Intervention** in any intervention stage sub-grid (Start, Provided, or Recommended) to enter the interventions.

### Intervention Stage:

Start: Interventions the eligible adult had in place when APS received the report.

Provided: Interventions provided by APS or other professionals during the report.

Recommended: Interventions recommended by APS or other professionals during the report.

Closure: **No interventions need to be entered in this stage.** It will be assumed that interventions entered in other stages (Start, Provided, Recommended) with a disposition of “In Place” or “Provided/Obtained” are still in place at the time of case closure.

**Intervention Category:** See the breakdown below for category options.

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### Intervention Disposition:

In place: Intervention(s) obtained by/for the eligible adult prior to the report being initiated by APS that are still present at case closure.

Provided/Obtained: Intervention(s) the APS Specialist or other professionals assisted the eligible adult/caregiver in obtaining.

Referred: Information regarding the intervention(s) that were given to the eligible adult/caregiver.

Refused: Needed intervention(s) that were refused by the eligible adult/caregiver.

Unavailable: Needed intervention(s) that were unavailable to the eligible adult/caregiver (e.g. lack of resources).
