SUBJECT: FY 26 Cost Maximum Adjustment and Rate Change for SFCW and Home Delivered Meals

Effective July 1, 2025, the cost maximum for the average statewide monthly cost for care in a nursing facility will increase to \$5,262.08. The amount will increase to \$3,157.25 for participants who are restricted to the 60% of the monthly cost maximum.

The unit rates remain the same, with the exception of an increase for the Structured Family Caregiving Waiver (SFCW) and Home Delivered Meals (HDM).
