The Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) policy manual has been updated to include additional language as described in the appendices below.

> 5.00 Appendix 1	Legal References for Adverse Action	<ul> <li>Updates to the following sections include:</li> <li>"Non-Compliant with Care Plan" - added General Health Evaluations (GHE) along with the legal reference.</li> <li>"Program Eligibility Criteria Not Met-State Plan Consumer-Directed Services" - added an attendant for CDS cannot be a consumer receiving CDS along with the legal reference.</li> </ul>
