SUBJECT: HCBS Providers Applying to Assist with Participant Reassessments

Home and Community Based providers who are interested in conducting reassessments for their HCBS participants will need to make an application for a participation agreement. It may take some time to process the application due to the volume which may be received. Applications which are received prior to July 1st will go into effect July 1, 2012, regardless of the date they are received or processed. Applications received after July 1, 2012, will go into effect on the date the application is received. Providers will not be able to bill for reimbursement until they have received an e-mail notification verifying that the participation agreement has been processed. The Title XIX Participation Agreement for Reassessments and application packet can be accessed through the Medicaid Audit and Compliance (MMAC) Provider Enrollment web page at <http://mmac.mo.gov/providers/provider-enrollment/home-and-community-based-services/reassessment-packet/>. Providers who do not wish to conduct reassessments do not need to apply for the reassessment agreement.

MMAC is responsible for assigning Medicaid provider type 27 numbers, for billing purposes, to those providers who sign the participation agreement. Providers will not be able to bill for reassessment services prior to July 1, 2012. Only those services provided on or after July 1, 2012 will be reimbursed. See PM/VM-12-13 for additional information regarding the billing process, training requirements, access to the HCBS Reassessment Share Point site, and information which will be required to finalize the reassessment.
