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MEMORANDUM FOR ALL HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED CARE PROVIDERS

SUBJECT: Transitioning Participants from Adult Day Health Care into the Adult Day Care Waiver or the Aged and Disabled Waiver.

DSDS will begin transitioning participants who are currently enrolled in Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) services under the state plan on **March 20, 2013**. Central Office staff will manage the transition of participants currently receiving ADHC. Providers will be contacted with specific instructions before their participants are transitioned.

Adult Day Care (ADC) is now an additional service added to the Aged and Disabled Waiver. This waiver includes participants aged 63 and over. A newly created and approved Adult Day Care Waiver allows those aged 18 to 63, who have met nursing facility level of care to receive Adult Day Care services.

Changes from ADHC services to either of the waivers include the following: ADC services shall not exceed 40 units or 10 hours per day with a maximum of 5 days per week. One unit is equal to 15 minutes. No more than 2 hours per day will be reimbursed for transporting the participant to and from the ADC setting. Procedure code S5100 HC will be used for ADC services provided under the Aged and Disabled Waiver. Procedure code S5100 HB will be used for ADC services provided under the Adult Day Care Waiver.
