Subject: International Statistical Classification of Diseases (ICD) -10 Changes

Due to the requirement for all Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) providers to utilize the federally mandated ICD-10 code set, HCBS providers should be aware that effective October 1, 2016 **significant changes** were made to many of the diagnosis codes contained in the code set. Approximately 2,000 changes were made to existing codes and over 3,600 new codes were added.

It is imperative that provider staff responsible for billing ensure a current ICD-10 code is utilized when filing claims for any HCBS provided on or after October 1, 2016. Claims submitted for dates of service beginning with October 1, 2016 and containing ICD-10 codes that have been changed will be denied payment by MO HealthNet Division (MHD).

At this time, HCBS providers should not depend on ICD-10 data contained on either the CyberAccess home screen or the InterRAI HC within the HCBS Web Tool as this code set data may be obsolete.

To assist in determining the most current code associated with a given diagnosis, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has provided a 2017 ICD-10 Conversion Table located on their website at: <https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/ICD10/2017-ICD-10-CM-and-GEMs.html>.
