### **FUSION GOES LIVE**

Implementation Date: May 5, 2025

DSDS's new case management system, FUSION, will go live on **May 5, 2025**.

To ensure you are prepared for a smooth transition, please refer to INFO 03-25-01.

- All assessments originally due by April 30th have a new due date of April 20th to ensure no lapse of services for our participants.
- All provider entries into the Cyber Access/Webtool system will be restricted as of 5:00 pm, April 20, 2025.
- Cyber Access/WebTool will only be accessible on a "read only" basis until the go live date of May 5th.

During this transition period, feel free to begin reassessments on May assignments via the new paper interRAI reassessment forms.

#### **IMPORTANT !!!**

All provider reassessor information must be submitted through the survey link previously emailed by April 18th. Not completing the survey may result in the inability to access participant cases in FUSION which will prevent assessment completion and billing.

#### InterRAI assessment tool update

DSDS will transition from the version 9 interRAI assessment tool to version 10 alongside the FUSION System implementation on May 5, 2025. This update will enhance reporting and analytics, allowing for more effective tracking of quality metrics and population health trends to better serve our participants. Training opportunities for version 10 will be available soon - stay tuned for more details!

Saint Louis University, (SLU) has updated the <u>SLUMS form</u> to reflect a scoring change for question 8. Please ensure any previously printed copies are discarded and that you download and use the updated version, now available in the <u>HCBS Policy Manual</u>. Using an outdated form may impact a participant's eligibly, potentially affecting whether they can receive CDS from a trusted family member or must transition to an agency model service.
