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### Reminders

It is imperative to check the case record the day you are going to complete your assessment for any updates to the case:

- Is the case open?
- Does the participant have active Medicaid?
- Is there an open PCCP change request? Failure to do so could result in you completing an assessment in which you will not be reimbursed for.

Providers should encourage their participants to anticipate phone calls from assessors for the purpose of scheduling a reassessment within 3 months of their care plan expiring. Please share the <u>Preparing for an Assessment Brochure</u> to help facilitate this conversation. Participants **should not** call DSDS to schedule an appointment. The assessor will make the initial contact.



## interRAI Training

### **Quick Guide updates:**

Gld (<u>Managing medications</u>), <u>PCQ</u>, and interRAI <u>Coding</u> updates:

- (G1a), Meal Prep: ability to put meals together regardless of nutrional value
- (G1d), Managing Medications: "calling pharmacy or doctor" has been removed as a subtask component.
- (Glg), Shopping: Only refers to assistance needed while in the store.
- (G2j), Eating: Does not include carrying plate/tray to table.
