
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What is the InterRAI HC?


- It is a person-centered assessment that informs and guides comprehensive care and service planning in community-based settings around the world.
- The InterRAI HC provides a 'seamless' assessment system that spans multiple health care settings.
- A multinational group of clinicians and researchers began work on the InterRAI HC in 1993.


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Key Points when completing the InterRAI HC Assessment :

- Requires Communication
- You can ask the questions in any order you choose
- You may have to reconcile answers to questions when inconsistent responses are received.
- Be prepared: take a copy of the last reassessment to update and new forms to sign
