

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Home and Community Based Services

- ❖ Assist the participant in meeting their unmet needs by providing the assistance to remain in the least restrictive environment.
- ❖ Authorized services must address the unmet needs of the participant.
- ❖ Encouragement is a non-reimbursable task
- ❖ Medicaid funded services are available through:
 - State Plan
 - Home and Community Based Waivers

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Eligibility Requirements

- 18 years of age or older
- Active Medicaid status with appropriate ME code
- Blind Pension participants may be authorized
- Participant in a Transfer of Property Penalty may be authorized
- Meets nursing home facility level of care
