





Adult Day Care Waiver (ADCW)

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Adult Day Care Waiver (ADCW)

- Services provided outside the home, for up to 10 hours per day 5 days per week that are organized, therapeutic, rehabilitative and social in nature
- Includes:
 - Medical supervision
 - Medication services
 - Meals
 - Snacks
 - Transportation

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ADCW Eligibility Criteria


- 18 to 63 years of age or older
- Medicaid active
- Medicaid spenddown participants may be authorized
- Participant in 'Transfer of Property Penalty' may be authorized
- Have appropriate ME code
- Meets nursing home LOC

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ADCW Restrictions


- Persons who reside in a nursing or residential facility licensed by DHSS or any group home or residential type facility licensed by DMH are not eligible for ADCW
- Participants authorized for DMH residential habilitation services cannot be authorized for ADCW

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Cost Maximum


- ADCW is included in the overall cost of care
- ADCW along with other HCBS services shall be limited to 100% of the cost maximum
- When RN is authorized on a monthly basis, the visits shall be excluded from the cost cap


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ADCW

The individual plan of care is developed by:

- Participant
- ADC personnel
- Participant's physician
