PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- The cards are FREE to all Missourians.
- There are no enrollment forms, no restrictions, no age or income requirements, no waiting periods, no eligibility required, no exclusions, covers pre-existing conditions, no claim forms to file, no annual or lifetime limits, includes discounts on brand and generic medications, open formulary so that all medications are eligible for discounts.
- This program has a "LOWEST PRICE" feature that provides cardholders the lowest plan price on prescriptions at participating pharmacies (Medication Pricing/Discounts are calculated on the plans lowest negotiated contract price and the pharmacy's "usual and customary" price).
- This program can be used by people who have Health Savings Accounts (HSA), High Deductible Plans, and Medicare Part D.
- The program can be used as a standalone benefit or to get discounts on non-covered drugs.
- All Missouri residents are eligible to participate in this program.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Missouri Drug Card?

Missouri Drug Card is a FREE statewide discount prescription assistance program. The program was launched to help uninsured and underinsured residents afford their prescriptions.

Who is eligible to participate in the Missouri Drug Card program?

Every resident of Missouri is eligible to receive a FREE prescription drug card.

How do Missourians get a Missouri Drug Card?

Missourians can download a "FREE" card by visiting www.MSMA.org. Residents can also obtain cards at various physicians' offices, hospitals, and clinics. The cards are accepted at more than 54,000 pharmacies across the country.

How can Missouri Drug Card provide free cards to residents?

This statewide prescription assistance program is made possible and funded through the support of pharmacies and pharmaceutical companies.

What makes Missouri Drug Card different from other prescription programs?

- No enrollment forms
- No restrictions to participation
- No eligibility or income requirements/limitations
- No waiting periods
- No age restrictions
- No exclusions
- Includes pre-existing conditions
- No claim forms to file
- No annual or lifetime limits
- Includes discounts on brand and generic medications
- Open formulary so that all medications are eligible for discounts
- Confidentiality: No personal information will be sold, shared, or distributed.

Can this program be used by people who have insurance with prescription benefits?

This program was launched to help the uninsured people of Missouri afford their prescriptions. However, people with insurance can also use Missouri Drug Card to get a discount on medications not covered by their insurance (non-covered drugs).

What type of discounts can you expect when you use this card?

Average savings are roughly 30% with savings on some medications as high as 75%+.

What prescriptions are discounted with this program?

The program has an "OPEN FORMULARY" which means that all medications are eligible for a discount through this program.

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Missouri Drug Card Highlights

- **Free For Everyone.** All residents are eligible to get pharmacy discounts through this program. The program can be used to supplement most health insurance plans including Health Savings Accounts (HSA) and High Deductible Plans. It can also be used as a Medicare Part D supplement by providing discounts on non-covered drugs.
- **No Restrictions.** There are no enrollment forms, no age or income requirements, no waiting periods, no eligibility required, no exclusions, covers pre-existing conditions, no claim forms to file, no annual or lifetime limits.
- **Lowest Price.** This program has *Lowest Rx Price Logic* to guarantee that you get the best pricing on prescriptions (Card holders pay the lower of a discount off Average Wholesale Price-AWP, discount off MAC Pricing, or Pharmacy Promotional/Retail price). You can save up to 75% on your medications (average savings are roughly 30%)!
- **Medications.** The program includes discounts on brand and generic medications, open formulary so that all medications are eligible for discounts.
- **Accepted Everywhere.** The Discount Prescription Card is pre-activated and accepted at over 56,000 pharmacies around the country including most major chains.
- **Confidential.** No personal information is required to get a card.

Frequently Asked Questions

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How does this Prescription Drug Savings Program work?

Missouri Drug Card is partnered with companies that negotiates discounts directly with the pharmacies on over 20,000 name brand and generic drugs. These discounts are then passed directly on to cardholders.

Who is eligible to participate in the Missouri Drug Card program?

Membership to the Missouri Drug Card program has no requirements. Unlike insurance programs, there is no income, age, pre-existing condition, deductible, or waiting period restrictions. The program is designed to help patients nationwide who do not have prescription drug coverage or who have coverage but are subject to large deductibles, large co-pays, formulary limitations, dosing limitations, gaps, and/or any cash out-of-pocket expenses.

How much does the Missouri Drug Card membership card cost?

The Missouri Drug Card program is absolutely FREE. We provide this service to any and all Missouri residents that wish to save on their prescription prices. There are no premiums or deductibles associated with this program whatsoever. [Printable cards](#) are available free of charge from our website.

Which prescription drugs do they cover?

The Missouri Drug Card Program covers all FDA approved brand name and generic prescription medications. Use our [medication pricing tool](#) to search for your prescription.

What is the typical savings amount?

For the year 2012 the average savings was 32% off retail pricing for brand and generic drug prescriptions.

How do I use the Missouri Drug Card?

1. **Select a pharmacy:** Missouri Drug Card is valid at over 56,000 network pharmacy locations nationwide. In most cases, your current pharmacy will be part of our network.
2. **Submit your prescription:** Present your prescription to the pharmacist. If you need to transfer a prescription, bring your empty prescription bottle or label with you to the pharmacy.
3. **Present Missouri Drug Card:** Your card's unique code provides the pharmacist with the appropriately discounted prescription price. The price on the prescription is based on the pharmacy's contracted agreement with Missouri Drug Card and our partners.
4. **You Save:** Your savings will be clear once the pharmacist enters your filled prescription into the register. Whether the lowest discount price is the Missouri Drug Card's price, your present insurance program's price, or the pharmacy's already discounted price, you are GUARANTEED to receive the LOWEST price available!

Which pharmacies can I go to?

We have a constantly expanding list of over 56,000 participating major chain pharmacies and local pharmacies nationwide. Use the Pharmacy Locator to see if your pharmacy is in our network. We have also provided a list of [participating pharmacies](#).

Can I check a specific prescription's price before purchasing?

Yes, we have provided a tool that will allow you to look up the cost of your prescription at any pharmacy. This prescription pricing tool is located on our home page, or you can use this medication pricing link.

How can I be assured I am getting the lowest price?

The discounted price may vary by as much as 75% depending on the drug and the pharmacy discount rate contracted with Missouri Drug Card. While pharmacy prices may vary from week-to-week and by the geographic location, the patient is guaranteed the lowest price available regardless of whether it is the Missouri Drug Card price, your present insurance program's price, or the pharmacy's already discounted price.
