Division of Senior and Disability Services (DSDS) and Division of Community & Public Health (DCPH)

DHSS-DSDS administers six 1915(c) Home & Community Based Medicaid Waiver programs and state-plan in-home services for **children and adults with disabilities**. DHSS-DCPH administers one 1915(c) Medicaid Waiver program for **individuals living with HIV/AIDS**. Medicaid Waivers are awarded based on availability of slots, allocation, the individual's assessed level of need and date of service request.

Home and Community-Based Services Referral and Resources

Department of Mental Health (DMH) – Division of Developmental Disabilities

DMH-DD administers for 1915(c) Medicaid Waivers for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ID) or other developmental disabilities. Waivers are awarded based on availability of waiver slots, allocation, individuals assessed level of need and date of services request. Individuals can only be enrolled in one HCBS waiver.

The Division of DD provides eligibility determination, information services, case management support and monitors contract compliance, so that individuals with developmental disabilities have quality opportunities and choices to be fully included in the community.

Comprehensive Waiver

Eligibility

- Must be determined eligible by the Missouri Department of Social Services' (DSS) Family Support Division (FSD).
- Needs requiring care in an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID)

Community Support Waiver

Eligibility

- Must be determined eligible by the Missouri Department of Social Services' (DSS) Family Support Division (FSD).
- Needs requiring care in an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID)
- Have active ongoing habilitation needs
- Service needs are limited to \$40,000 annually and the individual must not require residential services (this limit may be exceeded on a case-by-case basis)

Partnership for Hope Waiver

Eligibility

- Must be determined eligible by the Missouri Department of Social Services' (DSS) Family Support Division (FSD).
- Needs requiring care in an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID)
- Have active ongoing habilitation needs
- Must live in a participating county of the Partnership for Hope Waiver
- Meets the prioritization of need established for this waiver
- Service needs are limited to \$12,362 annually & the individual must not require residential services (If there are special circumstances, individuals may be able to get more services up to a maximum of \$15,000)

MO Children's with DD Waiver (MOCDD)

Eligibility

- Under the age of 18
- Ineligible for MO HealthNet due to the deeming of parental income and resources
- Live with family
- Be eligible to receive waiver services
- Have an ongoing waiver habilitative service need
